The majority of our correspondence will be through email and will concern the program resources or solutions to specific problems that may be occurring in the industry. If at any time you would like to cancel your account please let us know as there is never any obligation or cost for you to participate.

Because you will be sending, receiving and downloading information from Gates.com, it's important that you contact your schools IT administrator and ask them to *allow / not block* emails from Gates. This will ensure that relevant and timely Tools for Schools information can pass through your schools firewall to you.

We have found that for best viewing please set your screen resolution to a minimum of 1200x800 or higher and screen zoom to no more than 100%. Anything other than this may cause distortion or lost links.

- (1) Tools for Schools web site where all elements of the program can be found.
- (2) Tools for Schools Performance Center eLearning for your student contain a wealth of informative content and test the student's ability to retain and understand via our exclusive training quiz found at the end of each segment.



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(3) Tools for Schools “Free” tool program. A program designed to reward the school for utilizing the eLearning tool and using Gates products. Schools can earn Gates diagnostic and installation tools by accumulating points based on program participation.

The Tools for Schools website includes four areas that host or link users to all training information. Becoming familiar with the site map below will help you navigate faster.

(1) Home or Program Details

– **Instructor Sign up** – Click on the *Instructor* button to register and use your email address at your school if possible. Your email address links your students to your class once they begin their training in the Performance Center. Also verify that your schools address is correct. Gates will ship “free” tools to school addresses only so the correct address is a must.

If you are already signed up for the program, then simply Log In, upper right hand corner, to your account to enable the system.

– **Student Sign up** – Students are no longer encouraged to sign up in the Tools for Schools Program. However, students are encouraged to sign up in the Gates Performance Center eLearning which can be found at <http://gatesaftermarkettrainingcenter.com>. Please read and understand the registration instructions fully before asking your students to sign up. It is important that the student input the email address that you signed up with where noted. This ensures they are linked to your class which is especially important when utilizing Performance Center training and the “Free” tools portion of the Tools for Schools.

– **Educators Welcome Kit** – After completing the sign up process you will be mailed a welcome kit which includes posters, cd’s and an overview of the program. Please note kits may be limited to schools with a large instructor base. Allow 4-6 weeks for delivery.

– **Earn Free Tools for the School** – Teaches your student that global companies like Gates research and develop products for both OE and Aftermarket. Partner with and purchase your Gates products from your local Gates Independent, CARQUEST or NAPA jobber.
